## **Specific Rules**

- Time allocated per item is 1 3 minutes, unless otherwise indicated.
- The **duration of each item** must be accurately timed and indicated on the entry form. This information is essential when compiling the programme.
- Each participant may enter three (3) items in the serious/classical music section including the programme. A program consists of one item only.
- Each participant may enter three (3) items in the light music section including the programme.
- No participant will be allowed to perform more than once in a section.
- The same song / piece may not be presented in more than one section.
- The use of a microphone in the light music section is compulsory (irrespective of age) as candidates are adjudicated on microphone technique.
- All works presented must be **memorised**.
- Movement and choreography is encouraged in the light music section.
- Please ensure that pieces entered as "Own Composition" are indeed, original.
   Where a poem is set to music, the poet's name must be indicated at registration. Participants found guilty of plagiarism will be disgualified.
- When singing in a language other than English, please provide the adjudicator with a translation upon registration.
- Please ensure that you enter for the correct category to avoid disqualification.

• The Music Vocal Classical Individual section the age of the participant must be picked from the list and is determined as on 15 August 2022.

## Information on CDs or any other compatible electronic devices:

- CDs or USB flash drives containing backtracks will be accepted. NOTE:
   Backtracks may not contain any vocals. Pre-recorded voices, enhancing the melody line of the voice, are not allowed.
- The repertoire must be suitable for the candidate's age.
- Imitation is sternly rejected.
- The duration of the item may not exceed the stipulated **3** minutes. The sound engineer reserves the right to fade out the music upon instruction from the Head of the division.
- Each CD/flash drive must be clearly labelled with the participant's name, track number and item number.
- The CD/flash drive must be handed to the sound engineer 30 minutes prior to the performance, or just after registration.
- The sound engineer will not be responsible for returning CDs/flash drives, so please make sure that they are collected at the end of the session.

## **CLASSICAL MUSIC SECTION**

#### Definition:

Classical music (small 'c') is Western instrumental, orchestral, vocal and choral music – created for both secular and sacred settings. It refers to serious music following long-established principles rather than a folk, jazz, or popular tradition. It is further classified into the Medieval (500–1400), Renaissance (1400–1600), Baroque (1600–1750), Classical (1750–1820), Romantic (1800–1910), Modernist (1890–1975) and Postmodern/Contemporary (1950–present) eras.

Singing of classical music refers to vocal music in the style of the classical composers and involve, lieder (poetry set to music e.g. by English, French, German and Italian composers), opera, operetta, oratorio and secular music.

- No classical song may be sung using a microphone.
- Acoustic accompaniment must be used. A capella is in a separate section.
- No cellular phone or backtrack accompaniment will be allowed.
- Any language is allowed. Please hand in a translation of the text in English at registration.
- Please indicate the composer and arranger of the piece.

#### PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ASSESSED BY THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Intonation
- Diction
- Voice projection
- Interpretation /musicality

# CLASSICAL MUSIC PROGRAM SECTION: COMPETITIVE

- No work presented in any other items may be performed in this section.
- A Programme must consist of 2 contrasting pieces of differing styles for primary school and a balanced concert programme of 3 pieces for secondary pupils as well as Open Men/Women.
- Performers must be dressed appropriately.

## **LIGHT MUSIC SECTION**

- Backtrack or acoustic accompaniment may be used in this section.
   Backtracks may not include vocals.
- A capella singing is allowed.
- Pupils accompanying themselves will be judged on their performance as a whole, meaning both the singing and the instrumental will be judged.
- The Music Vocal Light Individual section the grade of the participant must be picked from the list.
- Only one report and certificate will be given here.
